Dear Mr. Magliocco:

This is in response to your recent letter requesting detailed data on arsenic residues from sites indexed in the "Catalog of Federal Pesticide Monitoring Activities". I regret that the Secretariat, FWGPM does not have any of the residue data from any of the indexed sites. These data are determined, stored, and/or published by the responsible federal agency as listed in column #7. The data are only available from the appropriate addresses listed in appendix D, pages 449 and 450. Many of the data have been published in various scientific journals, principally in the Pesticides Monitoring Journal which began in 1957.

Should you wish to contact specific agencies for their data, it would be best to identify the sites for which you need the residue data and the component class(es). Some agencies may, however, be able to provide a tabulation of all their arsenic residue data for the Nation.
