Honeywell is committed to working expeditiously to complete a thorough investigation of Swann Park and take appropriate cleanup actions that are fully protective of human health and the environment. Remediation was done at the park in 1976 under the direction and oversight of a federal, state and local government task force. Recent sampling has shown that additional remedial action is necessary.

We will continue to work in cooperation with the City of Baltimore and under the direction and oversight of the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE). We are currently working with the City to develop and submit a plan for the remediation of the park to MDE.

Honeywell is prepared to communicate with all those who are interested in the work we do at Swann Park and will coordinate with the City to address community needs.
